BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. is a private company, located in the Netherlands (Einsteinstraat 30G, Purmerend), and is registered at the Dutch Chamber of Commerce (37098135).

Personal data

BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. uses personal data that are provided to us by placing an order, by visiting our website or by third parties contacting us. We process for example the following personal data:

- your name, surname;
- contact details, like address, email address, telephone number;
- company details, like (delivery) address, financial details (invoice address, bank details, VAT number;
- data regarding your visit to our website;
- personal details regarding a job application;
- all other personal data that you provide to us or that we can obtain in connection with the purposes as stated below.

We collect these personal data because you provided it to us. For example, when you place an order, when you sign a purchase contract, by contacting us through our website or by giving us your business card.

2. Purposes and legal basis

BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. can use your personal data for the following purposes:

- the selling of our products to you;
- general and financial administration;
- marketing and business development;
- for job applications;
- to generate statistics concerning the use of our website;

We may process your personal data according to the following legal bases:

execution of the agreement;



- to comply with a legal obligation;
- legitimate interest;
- your consent.

3. Retention of your personal data

BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. will retain your personal data for as long as legally required or for as long as necessary to provide you with any requested services or for any of the other purposes listed in this Privacy Statement.

4. How we share your personal data

In principle, BCFOODS EUROPE B.V., does not share your personal data with third parties. However, we may need to share personal data with third parties to help us provide services and products to you and run our website. These third parties are, for example, not limited to:

- Law enforcement bodies or other supervisors/authorities in order to comply with any legal obligation;
- Service providers where this is needed to provide us with a service and to provide data analytics services.

Sharing of your personal data with the above third parties is only for the purposes stated in this Privacy Statement and only on the basis of principles stated in this statement. Third parties to whom we provide your personal data are responsible for compliance with the privacy legislation. BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. is not responsible nor liable for the processing of your personal data by these third parties.

5. Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of text files, containing small amounts of information, which (when visiting our website) are sent to your browser and may be stored on your computer, tablet, mobile phone or other device (hereafter: device). The cookies placed through the website of BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. will not damage your device or the files stored on it. When we talk about 'cookies' we also mean comparable techniques, such as device fingerprinting. These cookies are sometimes necessary to remember your account settings, but also enable us to measure and analyze your behavior on our website. Only analytical cookies are used on our website and no personal data are stored.

6. Your rights

You have several rights concerning the processing of your personal data:

- The right of inspection. You can request to have an overview of your personal data processed by or on behalf of us;
- The right to have your personal data rectified, deleted or restricted (as appropriate);
- The right to object to or request the limitation of the processing of your personal data;
- The right to receive your personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format;



You also have the right, in certain circumstances, to require us to stop processing your personal data, but where we have compelling legitimate grounds, we will continue processing your personal data.
You can exercise these rights by sending a request to lilian.hottentot@bcfoods.com. BCFOODS EUROPE B.V. will submit your request within 4 weeks after receiving the request. You must take into account that circumstances may arise in which we are authorized not to comply with your request.
